

Spool Christmas Tree Pincushion

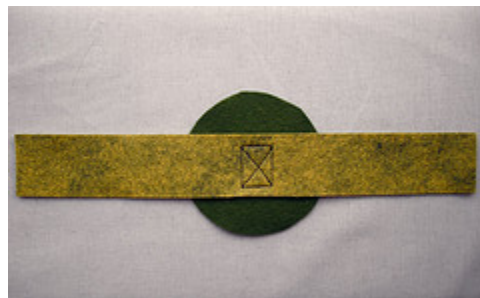


This is a super cute way to get in the spirit of the season - a festive wrist pincushion to help with your holiday crafting! It also makes a thoughtful gift for your sewing pals!



Materials:

3 different colors of wool felt
thread
velcro- hook & loop
pollyfill



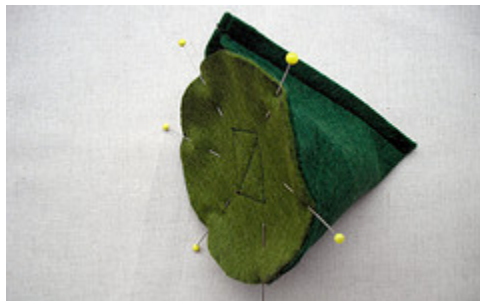
After cutting out the pattern pieces, stitch the wristband to the felt circle. I centered mine, stitched a square, and then reinforced it with diagonal stitching lines.



Fold the felt semi-circle in half and line up the straight edges. Stitch from top to bottom, using a 1/4" seam allowance. Now you have a little felt cone!



Place your base circle, with wristband attached, right sides together with felt cone. This means that the wristband will be INSIDE the cone.



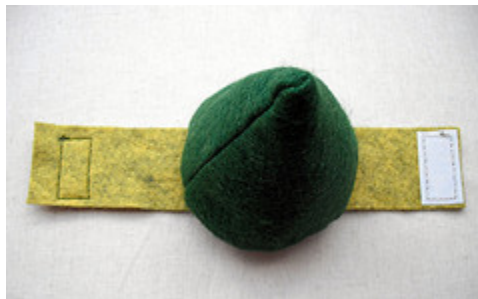
Pin all the way around the edge of the base circle.



Stitch around the edge, using a 1/4" seam allowance. Be sure to leave a small opening, so you can pull the little tree inside out.



Pull the tree inside out! Now, you can use the little opening to fill the tree with fiberfill, roving, or whatever you like to put in your pincushions. With a hand sewing needle & thread, slip stitch the opening closed.



Lastly, trim the wristband down to the length you like. Then, stitch on your 2 squares of velcro for the closure. Remember to stitch 1 face up and 1 face down!

Decorate the tree by adding pins and get stitchin'!

Spool Christmas Pincushion Pattern Pieces

Cut one from each piece, plus a 1.5" x 10" strip for the wristband.
